Inheritance Certificates - Application, Extract and Collection	<ol> <li>The Inheritance Certification online application portal will be closed from 7 April 2020 to 1 June 2020, and you will not be able to apply for an issue or extract of an Inheritance Certificate.</li> <li>If you have submitted an application before 7 April 2020, but it is not yet approved for collection, your application will be processed after 1 June 2020. If approved, and subject to verification of documents, you may collect the Inheritance Certificate after 1 June 2020 but before 1 July 2020.</li> <li>If you have submitted an application before 7 April 2020, and it has been approved for collection, but you have not attended for verification of documents, you may attend for verification of documents and collection after 1 June 2020 but before 1 July 2020.</li> </ol>	

Collection of Divorce Certificates and Attendance at Parenting Pact	<ol> <li>If you are due to collect your divorce certificate and attend Parenting Pact between 7 April 2020 and 1 June 2020, you may collect your divorce certificate and attend Parenting Pact after 1 June 2020.</li> <li>There will be no Parenting Pact sessions between 7 April 2020 and 1 June 2020. Filing of Court documents in pending/existing matters	<ol> <li>If you have a filing deadline for an existing application that falls between 7 April 2020 and 1 June 2020, this deadline is automatically extended to 3 weeks after 1 June 2020.
